

JOHN and ADRIENNE'S ENGAGEMENT BLANKET

Please note, this is a **description** of the blanket only, not a written pattern.



YARN COLOURS USED-

Yarnsmiths Create DK (available only from [WOOL WAREHOUSE](#))

One ball each unless otherwise stated

FJORD BLUE	ANTHRACITE GREY	STONE GREY – 2 balls
STEEL BLUE	CHOCOLATE BROWN	LINEN
VINTAGE TEAL	BROWN BEAR – 2 balls	OATMEAL
DUCK EGG	LATTE	PARCHMENT – 2 balls

Also one ball of Stylecraft Life DK in OATMEAL

One ball of Scheepjes Colour Crafter DK in VERVIERS

1. Granny Square Centre – 25 x Four Round Granny Squares with the Simple Join as You Go for the fifth round.

Followed by three rounds of granny stripes in the Life Oatmeal.

2. A Round of Plain Two Round Granny Squares with the SJAYG as the third round.

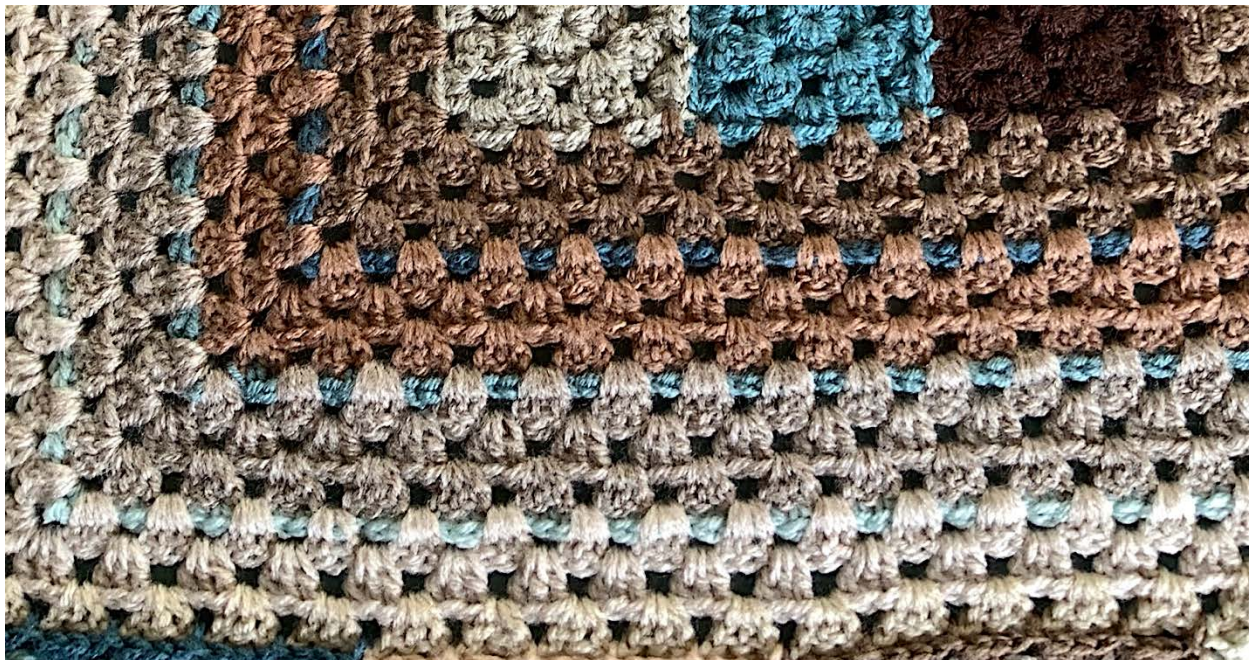


3. A deep section of Twelve Rounds of Granny Stripes with a DC round after every three.

Note – Unlike the video there are three Granny stripes between the DC rounds, and the stripes go round the corners.

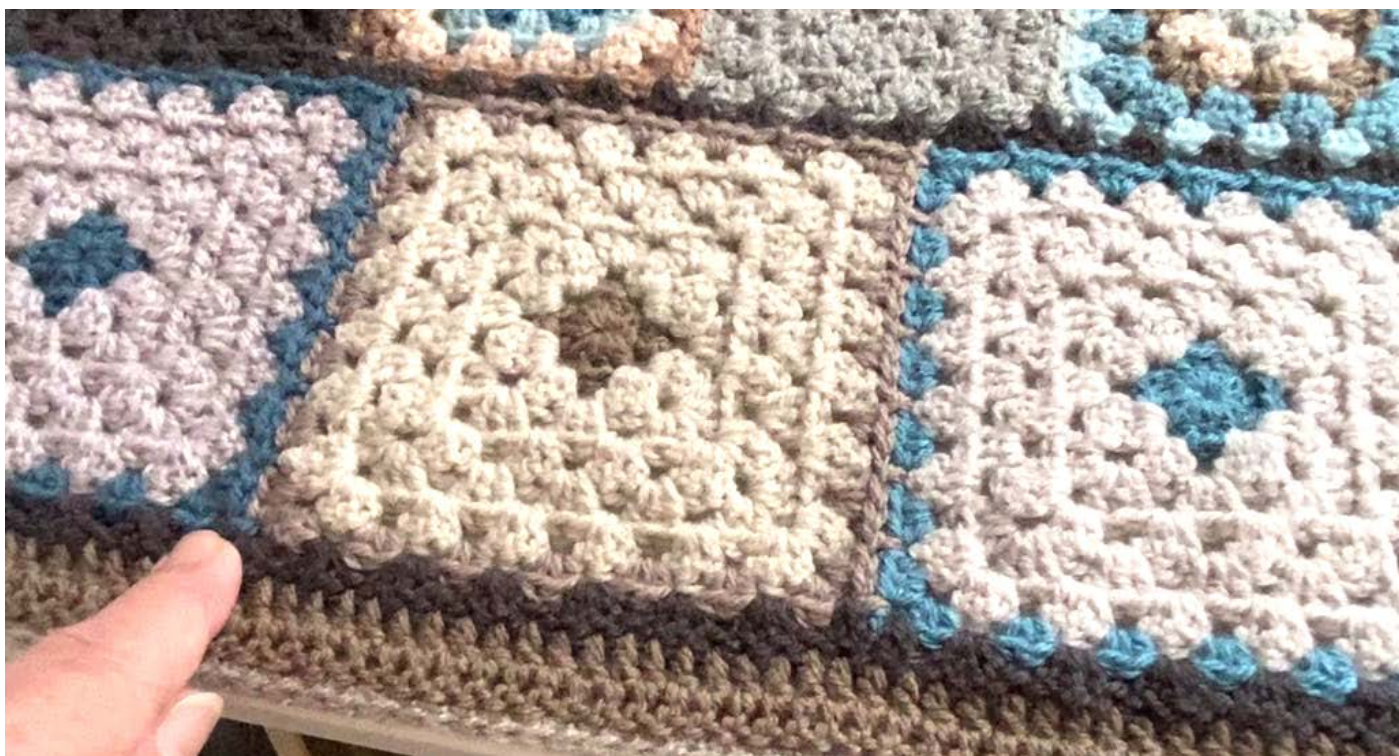


4. Another Round of Granny Squares. These are back to four rounds again with the fifth as the joining round, and alternating a plain square with a multi coloured one. I made the four corner squares all the same - plain square done in the Anthracite Grey.



Then don't forget, one round of Granny Stripe in Anthracite Grey.

5. A Round of Larger Granny Squares. They have seven rounds in total with the seventh being the joining round. They have Each is worked in two colours. The first round of the square and the joining round are done in the same colour. There is a paler shade for the other rounds.



6. Border and Edging – one round of Granny Stripe in Anthracite Grey followed by two rounds of Treble Crochet stitches and one round of Double Crochet stitches. See photo above.
